- ii. Aggravation from any motion, and corresponding relief from absolute rest, either mental or physical.
- iii. Haemorrhage: active or passive, bright-red from all the orifices of the body. In all diseases with constant and continual nausea.
- iv. Tonsillitis: can swallow warm food more easily; stitches and most symptoms, especially of throat, go from left to right. Sensation of a skin hanging loosely in throat; must swallow over it.
- v. Rectum: dryness and heat of; feels as if full of small sticks; knife-like pains shoot up the rectum; haemorrhoids blind, painful, burning purplish; rarely bleeding.
