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
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HPMV and Homoeopathy

Human Meta pneumovirus (HMPV) is one of the viruses that causes the common cold (upper respiratory infection).

The virus belongs to the Pneumoviridae family of viruses, along with respiratory syncytial virus (RSV). It was first identified in 2001 and has been spreading among people for many decades. It is found around the world.

When does HMPV typically spread?

Only a few countries monitor and report trends for HMPV, so we do not yet have a full understanding of how it spreads in all regions and climates.

Studies show that in temperate regions, HMPV mainly spreads in late winter and spring, at the same time as other common respiratory viruses such as seasonal flu and RSV, However.

What are the signs and symptoms of HMPV infection?

Generally, people infected with HMPV will have cold or flu-like symptoms:

- cough
- fever
- sore throat
- runny or stuffy nose
- body ache
- Headache.

It can make a few people quite sick, causing infection of the lung (pneumonia) or inflammation of the airways to the lungs (bronchiolitis, bronchitis). Symptoms of more severe disease include wheezing, difficulty breathing, chest pain, dizziness, severe fatigue, dehydration, or a persistent fever that does not improve.

Who is at risk for HMPV infection?

Human Meta pneumovirus is a common cause of upper respiratory infections among infants and children under 5 years old. While anyone can catch HMPV, infants, older adults, and those with health conditions like immunosuppression, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) and asthma are at higher risk for severe illness.

How is HMPV infection prevented? Is there a vaccine?

Preventing HMPV infection is similar to preventing other respiratory illnesses with actions such as:

- wearing a mask in crowded or poorly ventilated spaces
- improving ventilation where possible (such as by opening a window for air flow)
- cleaning hands regularly and thoroughly, with either soap and water or an alcohol-based hand
 rub
- Avoiding touching eyes, nose or mouth without cleaning hands first.

Having a strong immune system can also help fend off infections. Eating a balanced diet, exercising regularly, and sleeping properly help with that.

When someone is sick, they can avoid making others sick by

- staying at home if they feel ill
- covering nose and mouth with a tissue or bent elbow when coughing or sneezing
- wearing a mask when around other people
- improving ventilation, especially in shared spaces
- Regularly cleaning hands and disinfecting frequently touched surfaces.

There is currently no vaccine licensed for use against HMPV, but research is ongoing.

How is HMPV infection treated?

As HMPV is a cold virus, people can treat their symptoms with over-the-counter medicines to treat pain, fever, stuffy nose and cough. Getting plenty of rest and staying hydrated also helps. Currently, there is no approved antiviral medicine for HMPV. Most people feel better in a few days. In a small number of cases, when people need to be hospitalized, doctors may give them extra oxygen to help them recover.

Is there a test to diagnose HMPV infection?

- 1. PCR Test, a molecular test that detects the genetic material of the virus with high accuracy and is therefore regarded as the Gold Standard for diagnosing HMPV
- 2. Rapid Antigen Test, which provides quick results but are less accurate
- 3. Serological Test for identifying HMPV specific antibodies
- 4. In certain cases, Bronchos copy is advisable to look for changes in the lungs

Homoeopathic Management

EPIDEMICS

• CHANGE IN NATURE OF DISEASE: During an epidemic many at times it is found that maturation of the infective organism has resulted in the change in nature of epidemic & this requiring exhaustive research to found a different medicine since homoeopathic medicines aim to boost the individual's own

immune system, genetic mutation will not affect the person.• UNIDENTIFIED CAUSE: In case of epidemic where the infective organism is not found or if found is not always the signs & symptoms characteristic of the disease to rely upon.

The symptom severity of HMPV can be effectively managed by <u>homeopathic medicines</u> like: **Arsenicum [Ars]**

A MIXTURE BETWEEN DEPRESSION AND IRRITATION; oppressed, anxious, short respiration, with difficult secretion of mucus and dryness; burning and constriction in the larynx; cough, with arrest of breathing and expectoration of frothy mucus in lumps, or tasting salty in daytime, without expectoration at night; night cough, must sit up as soon as cough commences; deep, dry, unceasing cough, (<) after drinking or eating, during a walk in the cold air, when lying down.

Gelsemium Sempervirens –

Catarrhal affection growing out of the relaxed and debilitated condition of the system on the return of warm weather at the close of winter, SPRING FEVER; hoarseness, with dryness of the throat; burning in larynx, descending into the trachea; cough from tickling and dryness of fauces; sensation of soreness in chest when coughing. Catarrhal affections from motor disturbances, as spasmodic asthma.

Bryonia Alba -

Dry cough, crawling and tickling sensation in epigastrium or in throat, inducing cough, followed by mucous sputa; hacking cough, as if something (mucus) lodged in trachea, worse from talking or smoking; he presses with his hand upon sternum to support the chest during the violent exertion; sensation during cough as if the hea and chest would fly to pieces; aggravated by touch, motion, talking, laughing, eating and drinking; cough at night in bed.

Eupatorium Perfoliatum -

Useful in persistent fever with severe bodyache, productive cough which aggravates during cold and damp weather and improves in dry warm weather.

BILIO-CATARRHAL FEVERS; loose cough during a pyrexia, also at night, after measles (Stict); rough scraping cough; chest sore, must support it with his hands; flushed face; tearful eyes.

AntimoniumTartaricum

The hallmark symptom if this remedy is cold skin covered with clammy sweat along with wheezing and rattling cough.

catarrhal inflammation, beginning in larynx and becoming intense in trachea and bronchi; cough day and night, returning at short intervals, no sputa; nightly cough, with expectoration of thick, yellow, tough mucus; (>) sitting upright, from expectoration; (<) after midnight, after eating, when getting angry, sleeping in damp cellars; getting warm in bed.

Learn Better Be Better Perform Better

Vastness of the allied medical subjects like Physiology &
Biochemistry; Anatomy, Histology & Embryology; Pathology and Parasitology;
Forensic Medicine & Toxicology; Surgery; Community Medicine and
Practice of Medicine makes it difficult to study, to understand, to
grasp, to remember and to recall it during examinations. Especially
beginners, students of First Year find study of these subjects (Anatomy

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Biochemistry) very difficult and those who are coming from Vernacular language medium it becomes much harder as language difficulty adds fuel to fire.

Author also faced both the difficulties not only during student years but as educator also.

Author also faced both the difficulties not only during student years but as educator also. Many educators have to refer textbooks prior to presentation. Here are some tried and tested suggestions which author found useful in making him better educator of "Physiology and Biochemistry". They can help in understanding, learning, remembering and last but not least recalling the data at the time of performance.

1) Learn Concepts and Memorize Fact:

Topics learnt with deep conceptual learning tend to retain longed and can be recalled easily. Never mug up or memorize the topics. Make it clear by asking question to educator if not understood properly.

Facts where there is no concept can be memorized by "frequent revision" and by "PNEMONICS"

i.e. Blood Coagulation Factors, List of Essential Amino Acids, XII Cranial Nerves

2) Love to learn in Mother Tongues (DFT'EFQFF; J"EFQFFf

Students coming from vernacular language medium and find problem in First Year BHMS of learning in English. Topic if understood first in mother tongue and then in English will give better understanding than if tried directly in English. While studying in English, help of good dictionary and grammar books can be taken. Online help (AI) can also be taken. It can improve both knowledge in Physiology & Biochemistry and proficiency of English as a language.

3) Be content with whatever has been understood in first attempt

Some long and some difficult topics cannot be understood fully in first attempt. Be content with whatever is understood and learnt. Then restudy the same topic next day. Repeat till the topic is understood fully. Each next try gives better understandings of same topic.

4) Use textbooks

Textbooks have better explanation of concepts.

Readymade answer books should be refereed for the Performa of presentation and to have a quick look before presentation.

5) Long topics must be broken down into small parts and then they should be learnt in sequences.

Journey of thousand miles begins with single step.

To score a century we must hit one first.

Topics which look too long must be broken down into parts. Then they must be studied in sequence.

6) Try imagination to the level best

Topics learnt with imagination can be remembered for a very longer period of time and can be recalled very easily. Help of technology (audio and video) can be taken.

7) Revise

Revised topics tend to be remembered for a longer period of time. Each revision takes less time than the previous effort.

- 8) Take note while learning, after study is over at college, go to study place and learn again with the help of textbook.
- 9) Take breaks in between: Learn till your maximum capacity then have break. No screen time during break. Short walk some stretching or a chat with good old friend or breathing exercise can be tried. In between breaks help to lessen the stress and reenergize oneself.


