- (1) Vicarious menstruation; nosebleed when menses should appear; blood spitting or haemoptysis. Mucous membrane are all dry.
 - (2) Polypi; swelling at root of nose. Takes cold at every change of weather. Fat, fair, flabby and perspiring and cold, damp and sour.
 - (3) Intolerable pressive pain in eyeballs; could not turn the eyes without turning the whole body; worse especially on making false step. Sensation as if eyes were too large for the orbits.
 - (4) Throbbing pain deep in eyes, Pupils dilated. Heat, redness, throbbing and burning are prominent.
 - (5) Profuse, burning, acrid discharge. Floating black spots. After exposure to glare of fire; foundrymen. Parenchymatous keratitis of syphilitic origin with burning pain.
